Central Ohio Rotary Fliers Membership Rules and Regulations

1. Everyone flying at the CORF site **must** be a current CLUB and Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA) member (AMA membership is required for insurance requirements).
2. Visiting pilot are permitted to fly as a “guest” (on a limited term basis) with a current CORF member present. The guest must be a current member of AMA.
3. Membership is for 1 year from April 1—March 31 of the following year.
4. Membership fees paid after December will be prorated at 1/2 price for year
5. New members will be assessed a one time initiation fee of \$25.00.
6. Current AMA safety code shall be followed at all times.
7. Radio Frequency Control must be adhered to. CORF or AMA membership cards must be in place in the frequency control board when flying. If flying on 2.4 ghz. Member must place card in slot on frequency control board
8. There will be no transmitting if your frequency is in use by another member. Members must coordinate amongst themselves if there is a frequency conflict.
9. Flying permitted only in front of the flight line as designated by flying stations. No hovering or flying in the pit or parking areas.
10. Member access on the site will be limited to the “flying” areas at all times unless retrieving a downed model outside the limits of the “flying” area.
11. Non flying visitors and spectators are welcome to watch as long as a member is present.
12. Members will access the flying site via the former landfill entrance drive gate. It is the responsibility of the last person to leave the site to lock and secure the gate.
13. There will be no flying when site maintenance or mowing is being conducted.
14. Flying hours at site will be limited to 8:00 am to Dark daily.
15. There are no refuse containers onsite therefore Members must remove all trash from site.
16. CORF members shall not tamper with any CITY owned property or equipment present onsite.
17. All members are required to treat the site as tenants and are to respect the requirements of the access agreement granted by the CITY.
